YOUTH LEADERSHIP & CIT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATOR \$2100 - \$2300, + \$200 bonus*	1	Provide leadership and supervision to the Youth Leadership Programs in conjunction with the Program Director. Provide administrative and logistical support to Youth Leadership Program Coordinators. Enrich current program curricula. Assist in providing direct leadership & supervision to the CIT Program. Must live on site. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
CIT (Counselor in Training) Program Coordinator \$1350 - \$1650, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Maintain primary responsibility for planning and implementing the Counselor in Training Program. Work with Leadership staff to provide teens ages 16 & up with programming based on a curriculum that focuses on leadership skills & service. HEALTH SUPERVISOR \$2700 - \$3500, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for the health and safety of campers and staff. Primary responsibility in overall management of the Health Center and medical supplies. Responsible for dispensing medications and daily first aid. Must be a licensed Physician, RN, LPN, EMT or paramedic. Must be willing to work weekdays and Sundays. Position can be divided by camp sessions (e.g. to work half of the Summer) depending upon availability of coverage. MINIMUM AGE OF 25.
ASSISTANT HEALTH SUPERVISOR \$1800 - \$2200, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for the health and safety of campers and staff. Work in conjunction with the Health Supervisor to maintain Health Center and medical supplies, dispense medications, and daily first aid. Must be a licensed Physician, RN, LPN, EMT or paramedic. Must be willing to work flexible hours to include weeknights. Position can be divided by camp sessions (e.g. to work half of the Summer) depending upon availability of coverage. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
FOOD SUPERVISOR \$3000 - \$3600, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for food preparation and ordering, supervision of kitchen staff and maintaining the kitchen within the requirements of the State Board of Health and the American Camp Association. Must have a ServSafe food handler's certification. Experience is a must. MINIMUM AGE OF 25.
ASSISTANT FOOD SUPERVISOR \$2300 - \$2900, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for assisting in all aspects of kitchen operations including food preparation. Experience is a must. MINIMUM AGE OF 25.
DISHWASHER \$800 - \$1100, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for sanitizing all camp dishes, assisting with meal preparation and serving, and maintaining the utmost cleanliness of the kitchen and cafeteria areas. MINIMUM AGE OF 17.

MINIMUM AGE OF 18.
