| YOUTH LEADERSHIP PROGRAM COORDINATOR \$1350 - \$1650, plus \$200 bonus* | 4 | Plan & implement our summer programs for our Youth Leaders along with a team of three other staff. This includes our advanced co-ed camping leadership programs (ACE I & ACE II) for 13 – 16 year olds and our Counselor In Training (CIT) program for teens ages 15 & up. Supervise health center when Health Supervisor is not present. Must hold current lifeguard certification. Swim instructor certification preferred. MINIMUM AGE OF 21. |
| HEALTH SUPERVISOR \$2700 - \$3800, plus \$200 bonus* | 1 | Responsible for the health and safety of campers and staff, maintaining health center and medical supplies, dispensing medications and daily first aid. Must be a licensed Physician, RN, LPN, EMT or paramedic. MINIMUM AGE OF 21. |
| FOOD SUPERVISOR \$3000 - \$3600, plus \$200 bonus* | 1 | Responsible for food preparation and ordering, supervision of kitchen staff and maintaining the kitchen within the requirements of the State Board of Health and the American Camp Association. Must have a ServSafe food handler's certification. Experience is a must. MINIMUM AGE OF 25. |
| ASSISTANT FOOD SUPERVISOR \$2200 - \$2800, plus \$200 bonus* | 1 | Responsible for assisting in all aspects of kitchen operations including food preparation. Experience is a must. MINIMUM AGE OF 25. |
| DISHWASHER \$800 - \$1100, plus \$200 bonus* | 1 | Responsible for sanitizing all camp dishes, assisting with meal preparation and serving, and maintaining the utmost cleanliness of the kitchen and cafeteria areas. MINIMUM AGE OF 17. |
