YOUTH LEADERSHIP & CIT PROGRAM MANAGER \$1800 - \$2750, + \$200 bonus*	<i>Position filled</i>	Provide leadership and supervision to all Youth Leadership programs. Provide administrative and logistical support to Youth Leadership Program Coordinators. Enrich current program curricula. Assist in providing direct leadership & supervision to the CIT program. Must live on site. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
CIT (Counselor in Training) PROGRAM COORDINATOR \$1700 - \$1900, plus \$200 bonus*	<i>Positions filled</i>	Maintain primary responsibility for planning and implementing the Counselor in Training Program. Work with Leadership Staff to provide teens ages 16 & up with programming based on a curriculum that focuses on leadership skills & service. Must have experience supervising teens and planning program. Must live on site. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
ACE (Advanced Camping Experience) PROGRAM COORDINATOR \$1700 - \$1900, plus \$200 bonus*	2	Plan & Implement the advanced co-ed camping and leadership program for teens ages 13-16. Must have experience in advanced camping, team building and outdoor living skills. Must be willing to have some days off that alternate with the general camp schedule. Must live on site. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.

CHALLENGE COURSE MANAGER \$1700 - \$2200, plus \$200 bonus*	<i>Position filled</i>	Supervise low ropes, climbing wall, and high ropes course activities within ACCT & ACA standards. Must be able to attend certification through ESI in mid May at Jameson. This position must be combined with assumption of other responsibilities at camp and can be combined with most other positions. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
POOL SUPERVISOR	<i>Position filled</i>	Implement pool activities within American Camp Association, American Red Cross, and the board of health guidelines. Current lifeguard certification &/or swim instructor certification preferred. Must be a high school graduate or equivalent. Position must be combined with assumption of other responsibilities at camp. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
WELLNESS COORDINATOR \$1500 - \$1750, plus \$200 bonus*	<i>Position filled</i>	Responsible for camp programming focused on healthy living choices, nutrition, exercise. Wellness Coordinator will lead implementation of weekly activities and Wellness Camp in July. Training or background in health, exercise, or recreation preferred. Position can be combined with assumption of other responsibilities to be residential (e.g. Cabin Counselor / Wellness Coordinator). MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
HEALTH SUPERVISOR \$2700 - \$3600, plus \$200 bonus*	<i>Position filled</i>	Responsible for the health & safety of campers and staff. Primary responsibility in overall management of the Health Center and medical supplies. Responsible for dispensing medications & daily first aid. Must be a licensed Physician, RN, LPN, EMT or paramedic. Ability to work Sundays preferred. Position can be divided by camp sessions (e.g. to work half of the Summer) depending upon availability of coverage. MINIMUM AGE OF 25.
ASSISTANT HEALTH SUPERVISOR OR ASST HEALTH SUPERVISOR / CABIN COUNSELOR \$1600 - \$2300, plus \$200 bonus*	<i>Position filled</i>	Responsible for assisting in all aspects of health & safety of campers and staff. See Health Supervisor description. Training or background in healthcare preferred. Must be willing to work flexible hours to include evenings. Position can be combined with assumption of other responsibilities to be a residential position (e.g. Assistant Health Supervisor / Cabin Counselor). MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
FOOD SERVICE MANAGER \$3000 - \$3700, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for food preparation & ordering, supervision of kitchen staff & maintaining the kitchen within the requirements of the State Board of Health and the American Camp Association. Must have a ServSafe food handler's certification. Experience is a must. MINIMUM AGE OF 25.
ASSISTANT FOOD SERVICE MANAGER \$2300 - \$3000, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for assisting in all aspects of kitchen operations including food preparation. Experience is a must. MINIMUM AGE OF 25.
FOOD SERVICE SPECIALIST, or FOOD SERVICE SPECIALIST / CABIN COUNSELOR \$1500 - \$2300, plus \$200 bonus*	1	Responsible for assisting with meal preparation and serving, maintaining the cleanliness & organization of the kitchen and cafeteria areas. Live on site preferred. Position can be combined with the assumption of other responsibilities. MINIMUM AGE OF 21.
JUNIOR COUNSELOR / SUPPORT STAFF \$1000 - \$1100, plus \$200 bonus*	1	'Behind the scenes' assistance with necessary camp functions: camp laundry, Dining Hall cleanliness, prepping activities, & serving meals. Provide guidance to a group of 6 – 9 campers when not occupied with support duties. Should have prior experience participating in a Jameson program. Must live on site. MINIMUM AGE OF 17.
