About Jameson Camp

Since 1928, Jameson Camp has provided a safe place for children to thrive. Founded as a nutrition camp for children impacted by tuberculosis, Jameson Camp has transformed throughout the decades to meet the needs of young people. Today, the campus provides a safe and accepting environment where more than 5,000 children and teens get outside to grow inside. Year-round programming like outdoor education and teambuilding and leadership retreats contribute to the resiliency of youth and strengthens the skills of Indiana's workforce. During the summer, Jameson Camp welcomes more than 1,000 young people for a variety of day and overnight camps designed to fill the gaps created by systemic inequity.

Located five minutes from the Indianapolis International Airport with options available for a completely bespoke experience. Choose from single or multi-day service projects, a variety of teambuilding and leadership activities, catered meals, and use of on-site conference center, classrooms, campus-wide wireless internet, and overnight climate-controlled accommodations.

Projects Available

Strengthening Native Landscapes

Like most of Indiana, Jameson Camp has been taken over by several invasive plant species. Bush honeysuckle, Bradford pear, and garlic mustard are halting forest succession, reducing native pollinator populations, and limiting access to nature and educational opportunities for Hoosiers.

Your team can help! It's a wonderful feeling to gather with your team to tackle an invasive management project. Depending on the time of year and size of your team, you can help remove the species that negatively impact local ecosystems, plant native species, and care for the natural treasures that make getting outside at Jameson Camp a magical experience.

Pride of Place

Jameson Camp has eight cabins, a lodge, staff housing, the main office, and several outbuildings including an art center, pool house, and an outdoor education barn. Your team can help maintain these spaces and the trails that lead to them, ensuring the young people that benefit from Jameson Camp programming feel safe and welcome.

These projects are great for all skill levels, team sizes, and abilities. Build a treehouse so children can explore and play. Repair a bridge to ensure access to the 130 acres where teens build leadership skills for future professional success. Painting, light carpentry, cleaning, mulching, raking, weeding, and pruning are just some of the projects available to your team.

Jameson Camp has the unique ability to offer a day full of service and connection for your team. Following your project, teams will break for a catered lunch in a climate-controlled cafeteria before heading outside for some fun teambuilding activities. Jameson Camp staff will provide your team with thought-provoking puzzles, challenge course adventures, and esteem-boosting recreation!
